- 1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not **love**, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.
- 2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not **love**, I am nothing.
- 3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not **love**, it profiteth me nothing.
- 4 **Love** suffereth long, and is kind; **love** envieth not; **love** vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,
- 5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;
- 6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;
- 7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.
- 8 **Love** never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.
- 9 For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.
- 10 But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.
- 11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.
- 12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.
- 13 And now abideth faith, hope, **love**, these three; but the greatest of these is **love**.

WHEN IT COMES TO WORRY,  
THE FOLLOWING IS TRUE:

1. 40% of things you worry about never happens.
2. 30% of what you worry about has already happened. Learn to let go— Philippians 3:13; Hebrews 12:1-2.
3. 12% are needless worries, such as what someone thinks of about you.
4. 10% are petty and unimportant things—such as what's for dinner, will I be late, what to wear, etc.
5. 8% of what you worry about actually happens. Of this percentage:
  - 1) 4% of things that happen are beyond your control.
  - 2) 4% of what you worry about you actually have some control over. ■
