- <sup>10</sup> But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.
- 11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put way childish things.
- <sup>12</sup> For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also
- <sup>13</sup> And now abideth faith, hope, **love**, these three; but the greatest of these is **love**.

WHEN IT COMES TO WORRY, THE FOLLOWING IS TRUE:



- 1. 40% of things you worry about never happens.
- 2. 30% of what you worry about has already happened. Learn to let go— Philippians 3:13; Hebrews 12:1-2.
- 3. 12% are needless worries, such as what someone thinks of about you.
- 4. 10% are petty and unimportant things-such as what's for dinner, will I be late, what to wear, etc.
- 5. 8% of what you worry about actually happens. Of this percentage:
  - 1) 4% of things that happen are beyond your control.
  - 2) 4% of what you worry about you actually have some control over. ■
