Rooted in the Shall-Ness of God

The righteous have been planted like trees in the house of the Lord (Psalms 92:12-16). That means there has been a change in their *location*. They have been translated from the *kingdom of Satan* into the *kingdom of God's dear son*. That also means their *position* and *condition* have changed. The righteous were *in the world* lost but now are found *in Christ*. Those of us who are in Christ were once dead in trespasses and sin but are now quickened and made alive in Christ by the grace and mercy of God.

Not only have our *location*, *position* and *condition* changed but our *production* and output have changed. Before we were saved, we were unable to produce any wholesome fruit but by the help of the Spirit we can bring forth fruit to the glory and honor of God. We didn't have the wherewithal to change our output or our production but through the Holy Spirit He has provided everything we need to flourish and grow and to be fruitful even in old age.

The bible is clear and emphatic about the potential and the production of the righteous. In **Psalms 92** it says they (the righteous) **shall** still bring forth fruit, they **shall** flourish, they **shall** grow. It didn't say they might or most likely will. There is no doubtful disputation over the issue. If you have been planted by the Lord you **shall** without question, flourish, grow, be fat and be fruitful.

The growth and progress of a tree can be determined by looking at the growth rings of its trunk. Every year the tree adds a new layer of growth material on top of the material produced the previous year and when you look at a cross section of the trunk it shows up as concentric rings in the circumference of the tree. When there has been little growth the rings will be narrow. When there has been significant growth the rings will be wide.

Similarly, in the lives of the righteous, there will be seasons when growth will be rapid and conspicuous. In other seasons the growth will be barely discernable. But since you are the *planting of the Lord (Isaiah 60:21)*, your growth is assured. You shall flourish and be fruitful. Why? Because of the **fatness** that God promises. I'm talking about grace and the abundant **mercies**, and all the spiritual **blessings** that flow from the soil in which we have been planted. That soil is Christ and according to Ephesians 1:23, all the <u>fullness</u> of Christ has been made available to His church so it can flourish and grow and be fruitful.

As trees of righteousness, we must anchor ourselves with the sure hope of the **shall-ness** of God and hold fast to His word. In the prophecy of Isiah (40:31) we read: "But they that wait upon the LORD <u>SHALL</u> renew *their* strength; they <u>SHALL</u> mount up with wings as eagles; they <u>SHALL</u> run, and not be weary; *and* they <u>SHALL</u> walk, and not faint." There is not a hint of doubt in the words of the prophet.

After declaring that Jehovah was his shepherd and after ruminating and contemplating the many dangers that sheep face in their trek with the shepherd, David resolutely concluded "I will fear no evil for thou are with me". Then he proclaimed with positivity: "Surely goodness and mercy SHALL follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever" Psalm 23:1,6. Let us do as David did and as the Hebrew writer directs: ...let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wa-
