Theme: "Keeping Christ At Our Core In 2024"!

Annual church themes do not fall into the category of things that are essential to our salvation. Whether we have a theme or not is as they say, "neither here nor there." However, over the past 40 plus years I have found annual church themes to be useful in centering our focus on one thing at a time and over a period of time, the one thing is added to other things that we know. Before you know it, we gain the skill of being faithful over a "few things" (Matthew 25:21). But it starts with one thing at a time.

In the incident recorded by Luke (10:41), Martha was encumbered with "*many things*" while her sister Mary was focused on "*one thing*" which was "that good part" that would <u>"never be taken away from her."</u>

The principle that I discern from that incident is that there is a need to prioritize things. None of the things that Martha was concerned with were bad things, but they all were centered on temporal concerns. As such they would not serve lasting needs. They would all "*perish with the using*".

If we focus long enough and often enough on a few things, (one thing at a time) those things will become engrained in us and can "never be taken away" from us. Instead, they become foundation stones upon which our spiritual houses can be built. It is the idea that Jesus advanced in Matthew's gospel (7:24) when he said, *He that hears these sayings of mine and does them ... builds his house upon a rock*. Church themes help us focus on certain teachings that if we can become skillful at applying them, they will form a firm, rock-solid foundation for an unshakeable faith. Jesus said, the rains came, the floods came, the winds came and beat upon the house that the wise man built upon a rock, but it was able to stand.

Sadly, there were many among us whose faith did not stand during the storm of the recent world-wide pandemic. I believe it was because they did not keep Christ at the core of their priorities. The kingdom was not among those things that they sought *first* in their individual lives. As a result, when the storm came their lack of a firm foundation was exposed and at least as far as outward appearances are concerned their houses (faith) have suffered a "great fall".

We hope and pray that there are those among the fallen who will renew their commitment to Christ and His church and replace the sandy foundation of worldly values with the true and lasting values of Christ and His word. I also trust that those of us who kept standing will continue to *keep Christ At Our Core in Twenty, Twenty-Four.*



I mentioned in my remarks on Sunday night that there were several passages that depict Christ as being the core of our **faith** and **affection**. The one that I have decided to use with our theme this year is **John 14:23 (KJV)**

²³ Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

Our theme summed up in one sentence: *Keeping Christ at the Core of our faith and affection, keeps* us all moving in the right direction. •
