In the month of August, in recognition of our 94 years as a congregation of the Lord's church, we will be launching a campaign called, "30 Days of Fasting and Faith."

We will be declaring a public congregational fast that will last for 30 days.

This fast is to begin on August  $1^{st}$  at 7 am and end on August  $31^{st}$  at 7 am.

The 7 am time allows those who need to take medication with food to do so from 5 am to 6 am and take their medication, and then begin their fast. It also allows them to end their fast on the next morning and be able to break their fast with light sustenance and again take medication.

The fast will be a water only fast. No fruits, vegetables, juices, milk, etc. The only substance to enter the physical body will be WATER.

If you have any medical conditions that prohibit you from participating in a 24 hour fast,  $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ 

You are welcome to fast for longer periods, either consecutively or spaced out.

Once we have covered our full thirty days, we will allow those who want to do half days to sign up.

Sign up began this past Wednesday during our Summer Soul Food Series. We have flyers on the Welcome Center with instructions to help you with your fast.

The flyers are titled: The psychology of fasting.

There will be a banner in the foyer during Homecoming that will display all participants and the days they are fasting.

We are really asking that everyone participates and join us in seeking the face of God for our church, our community, our children, and our country.

In conjunction with our 30 days of fasting, we will be also having a 30 days of faith.

This campaign is designed to challenge and grow our faith by trusting the Lord to bless us as we bless him and honor him with our substance. No Fasting can be affective spiritually without sacrificing something. This faith campaign is one way in which we sacrifice in conjunction with our prayers to demonstrate that we are serious about seeking Him and determined to keep Christ at our Core.

**Pledge cards** are available and as usual, we are asking you to pledge \$1.00 for every year, \$94.00, and then multiply that by the number of decades. If the card does not correctly reflect your level of sacrifice, please feel free to write in the amount.

All pledges are due by Sunday, September the 1st, the day of Homecoming.

Please find a pledge card at the Welcome Center. They may be turned into me or placed in the pocket on my door.

If you have any questions concerning the fasting or the pledges, please see me at any time and I will do my best to answer them.

Again, this is a wonderful opportunity for us to demonstrate our sincerity and seriousness about keeping Christ at our Core, in 2024.
