#### Reflections on our 94th Homecoming Celebration

Truly the Lord has been gracious towards us in the last ninety-four years of our existence as a congregation. As is the case with God's people in every age, His faithfulness towards us is recognizable and undeniable. As I have chronicled in my book (A New Citizenry In An Old South) His goodness and favor toward us has resulted in the planting of more than a dozen daughter churches and the training and development of over fifty preachers to serve the brotherhood at large. Some of these Sons of West Adair have led the largest congregations in their respective cities and states. God has smiled on us, and we are thankful and humbled by His goodness, grace and mercy.

This year's celebration was the first time since the pandemic that we have used the lectureship format with two speakers each evening. We also reintroduced the Cornelius Mobley Memorial Concert. We are gradually getting back to what we used to do. Some people are still not over their Covid jitters when it comes to crowds, but we were able to attract over two hundred people on Tuesday and on Sunday. The fasting component and stewardship components were also reintroduced. We have a core of people at Woodlawn who can always be counted on to accept whatever challenges are put before them, which are aimed at deepening their faith and stretching their spiritual muscles. As a result, we were able to cover the entire month of August with individuals fasting and praying for personal growth and congregational effectiveness. There was a high num-

ber of individuals who met their pledge goals. As usual we were not seeking to raise funds per se, but to raise faith which cannot be done apart from a challenge to give up something of value in a liberal and sacrificial manner.



Members of Woodlawn and Christians from area churches who spoke with me were very appreciative of the opportunity to hear the messages presented each evening. They talked about how in-

spired they were and how much they benefited from the emphasis on the superlatives of Christ. On Tuesday He was presented as *The Divine Son of God*. On Wednesday as the *Supreme Spokesman for God*. On Thursday as the *Compassionate High Priest*, and on Friday His reign as *King of kings and Lord of lords* was highlighted. Throughout the course of the meeting it was shown that He has been highly exalted in name, honor, dominion and power. Our speakers did a tremendous job in casting light on all these features as they invited us each evening to "*Behold The Man*".

Sunday worship was the shining jewel in the crown of our celebration. It was the crescendo that ended on a high note. The three topics selected were designed to answer the question, since Christ is all that we have beheld Him to be, what then should our response be. Tony Herring told us, we should be "Living in Light of His return." David Wilson challenged us to: Behold, (the fact that) He Cometh with Clouds". And Corey Glover invited us to compare our "Current Circumstances and Future Fortunes."

We thank all our speakers, A.J. Walker, Xerxes Snell, David Wilson, Wesley Leonard, Marcus Watkins, Corey Glover and Tony Herring. They each did a tremendous job. We also want to commend each of you for setting aside the time to be here in person. Kudos to all of those who used their talents and abilities to serve and to make sure things went well. But, above all we thank God for sending His Son to be the author and finisher of our faith. And, as we approach the final quarter of this year let us be resolved more than ever to Keep Christ at The Core of our Faith and Affection!
