Theme: "Keeping Christ At Our Core in 2024"!

Our theme last year (2023) was influenced largely by the fact that we had survived COVID and were even able to prosper in significant ways. Though our attendance fell to a third of what it had been prior to covid, our income remained steady and even showed a significant increase. Our personal bonds grew stronger, and our faith was fortified. Not only did we survive but in many ways we thrived. So, last year we decided to celebrate and emphasize the fact that we were *Fruitful and Flourishing*, *Planted Like a Tree in 2023*.

This year we have been operating under the theme, *Keeping Christ at Our Core in* **2024**. I believe most of those who failed to remain faithful and fell away during the difficult and dangerous times of the pandemic did so because they failed to anchor their faith in Jesus Christ. Jesus made a forecast in Luke 6 that if we would build our spiritual houses upon the bedrock of His teachings, we could survive the storms that come to try the foundations of our spiritual houses.

Our focus for the entire year of 2024 has been to emphasize who Christ is, what He does and what he provides for our salvation and our sanctification. He summed up the situation when He said in John 15:5, "...Without me you can do nothing." We crafted a limerick to remind us of this essential idea which says, *"Keeping Christ at the core of our faith and affection keeps us all moving in the right direction."* We explained that the right direction is toward the <u>center of God's will and purpose</u>. The further we move toward the center the less likely we are to "fall off the edge."

As you look back on 2024, what is your assessment of your progress. Are you closer to the center of God's plan and purpose for your life? Are you more like Christ in the essential skills and habits of a mature disciple? Has your love for God grown deeper? How about your love for other disciples? Are you more concerned about the lost among us?

The Love Connection and **L-640** (Luke 6:40) **Mature Discipleship Program** is designed to help you acquire the core values/characteristics of Christ. Being conformed to the image of Christ is God's plan for every believer (Romans 8:29). The Holy Spirit is working in you and me to achieve this but it will not happen without our cooperation and participation. The theme for 2024 was a way of reminding us of that fact. The word "Keeping" in our limerick and theme was meant to remind us of our part. The *faith* has been *once delivered* but we have to <u>keep it (Jude 1:3)</u>. The *unity of the Spirit* has been divinely crafted and inspired but we have to <u>keep it (Ephesians 4:3)</u>. Keeping involves "fighting" and so we are commanded to *fight the good fight of faith*. It involves "laying hold on eternal life". and so we must keep a firm grip on what we have been given. (1 Timothy 6:12).

In a few days we will move into another year if God says the same. We will adopt a new theme, but it will not highlight a new or novel purpose. Our purpose remains the same. As I have explained before, themes help us to focus on priorities and to highlight those things that are the *few* things over which we must be faithful (Matthew 25). We look forward to sharing that theme with you on the eve of the new year. Grace and Peace!


