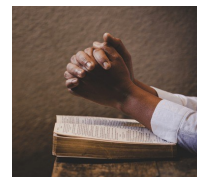

We did hand out registration forms and so we are anticipating more enrollments.

There were 22 Youth members in attendance, 14 parents, 2 youth who were non-members, and 16 Youth Council Members.
